**3. ENTRY FEES: SSGC Members:** \$10 for 1st artwork, \$5 per extra artwork up to 4 pieces in total. Plinths supplied. New work is encouraged, however, previously exhibited work may be accepted - exhibition space permitting.

**Non-Members:** \$15 for 1st artwork (any media, sculpture, paintings, ceramics, photo, etc.) \$6 per extra work up to 4 pieces in total.

**4.** Paintings must be ready to hang with wire across back and no bigger than **1 square metre**. 3-D works limited to no greater than **1** metre square of footprint and which can be handled easily by two people.

The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to arrange the exhibition to its best visual display advantage, even if this requires moving pieces to other plinths.

- **5.** All works to remain for the duration of the exhibition no early removals.
- **6.** Society members who are exhibiting **are requested to assist by manning the exhibition** time slot to **be confirmed** on delivery day. Exhibiting non-members are encouraged to do a duty-roster if possible.

Availability to man exhibition: Dates / Times .....

- 7. DELIVERY OF WORKS at the venue between 10am and 12pm on Thursday 5 April or 10am and 12pm Friday 6 April.
- **8. PICK-UP OF SOLD and UNSOLD WORKS** on Sunday 29 April between 2pm and 3pm FIRM. (If these times are impossible for you, please ring to make prior arrangements Robyn Burgess 0417 616 022) After three weeks the Society will dispose of the artworks at their discretion to defray costs.
- **9.** Whilst all care will be taken by the Society, artists are responsible for insuring their own works and guarantee to indemnify the Society against any loss or damage, however caused.
- **10.** The Committee will hang and arrange the exhibition. All efforts will be made to display all pieces to their best advantage within space limitations. Please notify us of any special conditions relating to your artwork.
- 11. Any decision by the Committee is final and binding with no correspondence entered into.
- **12.** The Exhibitor agrees to allow the Sculptors Society Gold Coast to use photographs of the entry to use in promotional purposes.
